Since 2005, Hawai'i Self Storage (HSS) awards financial scholarships to eligible students to pursue and obtain a college degree. This program is designed to help and support students financially to develop into future leaders in our community. 10 students will be selected for the scholarships, and it will be awarded based on required written essay and eligibility.

Eligibility

Be a Hawai'i resident and be a current high school senior. Must graduate from a high school in the State of Hawai'i.

Be enrolled full-time at a college or university.

The applicant must be enrolled full time and submit a letter of acceptance into a recognized academic degree program. Applicants must be enrolled with a minimum of 12 credits; HSS does not provide funding for part-time enrollment.

Complete the required attached application and essay. Only one application needs to be submitted in order to apply.

- 1. Tell us about yourself, and why you need this scholarship.
- 2. How will you use your degree to benefit and serve our community?

Completed application and essay musy be emailed by **February 15th, 2025**. Selected recipients are announced in **May 2025**.

Terms of Scholarship

4-year maximum term. \$1,000 awarded each year upon renewal qualification.

Student must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of **3.0** If student fails to qualify, student is still eligible the next year if GPA qualifies.

Winners must submit <u>official college transcripts</u> to Hawai'i Self Storage (address below) to renew. Due date for renewal is **JULY 15**th.

All checks will be written to the institution and mailed to recipient's address. Checks will be mailed first week in **AUGUST**.
